executive level experience. The Hays County Sheriff's Office employs approximately 350 civilian and commissioned staff. He has many awards to his credit.

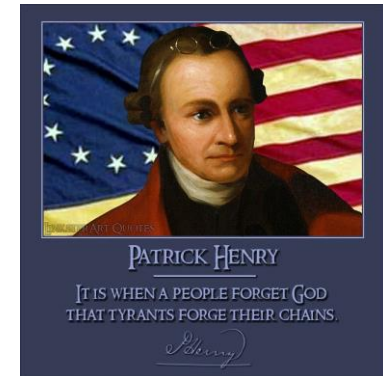
The SAR will also present the Law Enforcement Medal to Sheriff Gary Cutler.
